- Wearing a sleep headband for 3 nights at home to monitor brain activity during sleep
 - 1-2 weeks of practice at home to get used to wearing the sleep headband, if needed
 - Keep a sleep diary on study nights
- 2 visits to the Lurie Center for Autism in Lexington, MA
 - Complete assessments and questionnaires with the study team
 - Wear an EEG cap to monitor brain activity while listening to tones and clicks (Optional)
